

# Montgomery County Veterans Shuttle Service



Montgomery County is pleased to offer assistance accessing VA Healthcare benefits available to many veterans at little or no cost.

If you are a veteran or a caretaker of a veteran, Montgomery County will provide transportation to and from a nearby VA medical center at no cost.

Passengers must be currently enrolled in the VA Healthcare system in order to access healthcare services upon arrival. If you are not enrolled in VA Healthcare, but would like to enroll, please call our office for assistance. Please ask for assistance enrolling in VA Healthcare.

## HOW DOES IT WORK?

The shuttle operates four days a week and leaves from the following locations promptly at 10:30 am:

Passengers will be returned to their home address after 3:00 pm. This address must be in the general area the shuttle departed from.

## CALLING AHEAD

We encourage all passengers to call ahead and reserve a seat for the veteran and up to one adult caretaker.

The shuttle will leave all VA Medical Centers no later than 3:00 pm each day. Veterans must schedule their medical appointment between the hours of 11:30 am and 2:00 pm.
