Furthermore, Larry sat on the Boards of APMM (Assoc. of PA Municipal Managers) and was President of APMM from 2008 - 2009, MCATO (Montgomery County Assoc. of Township Officials), TMA (Transportation Management Association) and DVIT (Delaware Valley Insurance Trust) until his retirement he was the Chairman of the Delaware Valley Municipal Management Association. In 2006, PSATS presented Larry with the distinguished President's Leadership Award for his outstanding service to the people of Lower Gwynedd and to the Municipal Manager's profession. He is a Past President of the Kiwanis Club of Ambler and currently serves as Club Secretary.

In April the township staff, residents, business people, and Board of Supervisors will miss the professional "go-to" guy they have relied on for so many years. We all wish Larry the best in his retirement and if you get a chance to see him please thank him for his service over the years. Larry will spend his days in retirement perfecting his golf game, continuing to teach with PSATS and at Villanova, and spending more time with his wife, Brenda, his children, Carmon, Jennifer, and his grandchildren, C.J. and Lincoln.

### CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE

In last Fall's Newsletter, I reported that construction on the Spring House Shopping Center would be starting in the Fall of 2015, dependent upon approvals from State agencies. In the very near future it will be gratifying to see work begin on this project and we are looking forward to the opening of the Whole Foods Superstore and the revitalized Center in the Spring of 2017.

While as of this writing there is nothing new to report regarding the now-vacant DOW Chemical site on Norristown Road, this property is the focus of a planning study to determine the highest, best and most sustainable use for this significant property in our Township. That planning study will be completed in the next few months. The results of the study will be shared with our citizens.

For the 4th year in a row, the Lower Gwynedd Township Board of Supervisors approved a 2016 Budget and Fiscal Plan without a real estate tax increase. Lower Gwynedd's real estate tax of 1.223 mills is one of the lowest tax rates in Montgomery County. The Board of Supervisors continues to operate your Township in a fiscally conservative manner that is evidenced by its low taxes and Aaa Bond Rating from Moody's, it highest rating of credit worthiness.

# LOWER GWYNEDD TOWNSHIP POLICE 2015 Annual Report

### **Personnel:**

Retirements and a restructuring of the department's investigative unit left the department with two positions to fill in patrol in 2015. The police department proudly welcomed Officer Christopher Swenson and Officer Michael Cantrell to the department. Both new hires came to Lower Gwynedd through the Montgomery County Consortium testing and an intensive background investigation. They both successfully completed their field training and are proudly serving the community.

The restructuring of the department included moving Officer Beth Sanborn from patrol duties to a full time School Resource Officer for the Wissahickon School District. Officer Sanborn has also taken over the bulk of juvenile investigations for the department. The move has streamlined juvenile investigations and allowed Detective Glenn Fowler to focus most of his expertise in adult investigations.

### **Traffic Statistics:**

The Lower Gwynedd Police Department purchased a new traffic speed trailer that both warns motorists of speed violations and tracks traffic flow. Since acquiring it, the trailer (which self- charges with solar panels) has been in continual use until last week when it was housed for weather reasons.

### In 2015 The Lower Gwynedd Police Department:

- Investigated 550 Traffic Accidents
- Issued 631 citations for traffic violations
- Issued 581 warnings for traffic violations

### Miscellaneous

There were 76 reported cases of fraud last year. The most common occurring type of fraud was bogus IRS scams. The scam involves suspect(s) contacting residents demanding money for back taxes not paid. Victims are threatened with jail time and the payment is demanded to be immediate. *Residents are cautioned the IRS will not call you by phone demanding money.* 

There were 132 reported theft cases in 2015. Theft from unlocked vehicles was the fastest growing trend. Most vehicles were left unlocked and parked in front of or in the driveway of residences. Residents are urged to remove their valuables from their vehicles and make sure the doors are locked.

# STORMWATER MANAGEMENT 10 Tips to Prevent Stormwater Runoff Pollution

Stormwater is the runoff from precipitation that flows into storm drains or other water sources. Water and anything else that is in the storm sewer eventually flows into local streams and ponds. It is important to note that the storm sewer system is not treated or cleaned before being discharged into our local waters. Residents can help improve local water quality by following these steps:

- b Use fertilizers sparingly and sweep up driveways, sidewalks, and gutters
- Never dump anything down storm drains or in streams
- 💧 Vegetate bare spots in your yard
- 💍 Compost your yard waste
- 👛 Use the least toxic pesticides possible, follow labels, and learn how to prevent pest problems
- 💧 Direct downspouts away from paved surfaces; consider a rain garden to capture runoff
- 💧 Take your car to the car wash instead of washing it in the driveway
- Have your septic tank pumped and system inspected regularly
- 🁛 Pick up after your pet
- b Check your car for leaks and recycle your motor oil

### PLAYGROUND SAFETY

A quick checklist for parents

Place this list in a prominent area of your home for quick reference. Then, before your children head out the door for the playground, check that:

### Supervision is present, but strings and ropes aren't.

Adult presence is needed to watch for potential hazards, observe, intercede and facilitate play when necessary. Strings on clothing or ropes used for play can cause accidental strangulation if caught on equipment.

### All children play on Age-appropriate equipment.

Preschoolers, ages 2-5, and children ages 5 -1 2, are developmentally different and need different equipment located in separate areas to keep the playground safe and fun for all.

### Falls to surface are cushioned.

Nearly 70 percent of all playground injuries are related to falls to the surface. Acceptable surfaces include hardwood fiber/mulch, pea gravel, sand and synthetic materials such as poured-in-place, rubber mats or tiles. Playgrounds surfaces should not be concrete, asphalt, grass, blacktop, packed dirt or rocks.

### Equipment is safe.

Check to make sure the equipment is anchored safely in the ground, all equipment pieces are in good working order, S-hooks are entirely closed, bolts are not protruding, there are no exposed footings, etc.

# WHITPAIN/LOWER GYWNEDD JOINT TRAIL PROJECT

Amajor part of the Whitpain/Lower Gwynedd Joint Trail Project was completed on January 21, 2016 when a Walking bridge spanning the Wissahickon Creek was put in place. The bridge will connect the Green Ribbon Trail near Penllyn Woods in Lower Gwynedd to trails in Whitpain that will eventually connect to the Montgomery County Community College. The project was originally proposed to the Montgomery County Planning Commission in 2008 when a grant application was approved as part of the Montgomery County Open Space Program. A boardwalk will be built from the bridge on the west (Whitpain) side of the bridge through wetland areas. The project is scheduled to be completed in 2016. The total cost of the project is \$315,000.

According to the Consumer Product Safety Commission, one generator can produce as much carbon monoxide as hundreds of cars.


Here are some tips for using a portable generator:




