



Lower Gwynedd to Again Honor Veterans in 6th Annual Ceremony, INDOORS, on Saturday, November 9, 2019

Lower Gwynedd Township is pleased to announce that it will honor America’s veterans with its 6th annual ceremony, on **Saturday, November 9, 2019, from 10:30 a.m. to noon**. In a change from prior years, this year’s ceremony will be held **INDOORS, at the Wissahickon High School Auditorium, located off of Dager Road, in Lower Gwynedd**. Prior to the 2019 ceremony at the Auditorium, the speakers will present a wreath at Lower Gwynedd’s Veterans Memorial Park, in Spring House, home to the seven-foot high metal “Wreath of Honor” sculpture, which the Township dedicated in 2006. The speakers will also present a wreath at the Wissahickon High School’s Veterans Memorial.

The ceremony will take place indoors, and rain or shine. As in years past, the 2019 ceremony will include remarks by veterans of the **Army, Marine Corp, Navy, Air Force and/or Coast Guard**.

Patriotic musical numbers will, again, be performed by the Wissahickon Middle School Marching Band and the Bethlehem Baptist Church Men’s Choir, along with the WHS Camerata. Also participating will be veterans from Ambler’s Daniel W. Dowling American Legion Post 769, and Ambler’s Boy Scout Troop 540. Several Lower Gwynedd restaurants will provide complimentary **“Taste of Lower Gwynedd” refreshments, at the WHS Lower Cafeteria, immediately following the ceremony.**

All Township residents, and neighbors from surrounding Montgomery and Bucks County municipalities, as well as all veterans and their families, are invited and encouraged to attend the ceremony. **Free parking will be provided at Wissahickon High School, using the Dager Road entrance.**
