2021 Budget Up For Adoption On December 8


The Board of Supervisors will consider adopting the Township's proposed 2021 budget at its meeting on Tuesday, December 8. The <u>virtual meeting begins at 7 p.m.</u>

The budget keeps real estate taxes at their current rate and leaves sewer user charges unchanged. The real estate millage remains 1.223 mils, which means a residence with the median Township assessment of \$429,000 will pay \$524.67 in real estate taxes in 2021.

The budget is available for review at the Township Building between 8:30 a.m. and 4 p.m. by making arrangements with staff. The budget is also <u>available by clicking here</u>.

Work Begins On Intersection Project


