Deadline For County Restaurant Grant Program Is This Friday

Montgomery County restaurants and food service businesses may be eligible for economic development funding under a new program started by the County Commissioners.

Recognizing the importance of the restaurant and food service industry as a cornerstone of Montgomery County's economic and workforce development, the Commissioners are making \$5 million in economic development funds available in a grant program.

The application for restaurants and food services businesses closes at noon this Friday, January 8.

Applicants must be a for-profit restaurant, food truck, deli, bakery, brewery, distillery, vineyard, caterer or other food service for-profit entity with a physical location in Montgomery County that has been in operation since January 1, 2020.
