Township To Remember Residents Who Lost Their Lives To COVID-19

The Board of Supervisors will place 37 candles at the Township Building on January 19 as part of a nationwide ceremony to remember and honor those who lost their lives to COVID-19.

The tribute will begin at 5:30 p.m. It is being organized by the Presidential Inaugural Committee. Cities across the country are being encouraged to illuminate buildings and ring church bells at 5:30 p.m. as part of the tribute. The Township encourages the community to join in the tribute.

The 37 candles at the Township Building will be in memory of 37 Township residents who died from COVID-19.
