**Lower Gwynedd Township and WVHS** hosting speaker Russ Bellavance and his presentation titled: **Gwynedd, Our Fair Land Through the Years**

Join us on **Tuesday, June 4 at 6:30 PM** at the Lower Gwynedd Township municipal building (1130 North Bethlehem Pike in Spring House) as the Lower Gwynedd Historical Advisory Committee and the Wissahickon Valley Historical Society present a program about the history of Gwynedd. Our speaker is Russ Bellavance (pictured here), a retired history teacher and the Past President of the historical society who resides in Lower Gwynedd.



Since its settlement by a group of Welsh families in 1698, the land which those settlers called Gwynedd (Welsh for Fair Land) has seen many changes. Some are due to the particular set of individuals and families that settled here, with their unique cultures and traditions. Others are due to the reactions of residents to political and technological changes in the larger community. Today, Lower Gwynedd, Upper Gwynedd and North Wales Borough enjoy the inheritance of these earlier residents.
