Dear Customer,

We are contacting you about an upcoming project occurring in Ambler Borough, and Lower Gwynedd and Whitpain Townships that will enhance the local electric distribution system. The project is part of a \$4.5 million infrastructure investment in our region to help withstand more frequent and damaging storms, improve reliability by reducing the frequency of outages that cannot be prevented, and support the adoption of cleaner energy resources such as solar and electric vehicles.

Due to the scale of this project, work associated with upgrading and installing new equipment will occur in phases and is expected to last multiple years. For this first phase, our work will occur on Old Penllyn Pike and Pen Ambler Road. The map featured in the enclosed fact sheet outlines where work is slated to occur, specifically within these areas.

Construction for the first phase of work is anticipated to begin in early 2025 and is expected to be completed in 2026. We have developed a plan to minimize direct customer impact as much as possible and to complete the project in a safe and timely manner.

As part of this project, we anticipate that tree removals and tree trimming work will be required. During the next few weeks, qualified PECO contractor Davey Resource Group (DRG) will be in your area surveying the tree work to determine the impact. If there is required tree work on your property, we will contact you directly to review in-person.

We will keep you informed about our work and will update you as the project progresses. Be on the lookout for additional information in the coming months.
