Purpose: To revitalize Bethlehem Pike in hopes to bring a new sense of community and civic pride to both residents and businesses.

Where: Lower Gwynedd’s Comprehensive Plan calls for the revitalization of the two-mile stretch of Bethlehem Pike from the township building to Dager Road.

When: Improvements have already taken place in front of the Township Building and in front of Spring House Tavern. Phase I (Township Building to Rotelle Drive) is expected to be started by Fall of 2004.

Result: The creation of a village center in Spring House, with new landscaping, a reconfigured roadway, and more consumer/ pedestrian friendly sidewalks and parking.
