### **1. Call to Order**

Chair Morris called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m.

### **2. Public Comment**

Ms. Meek introduced herself to the Park and Recreation Board. Ms. Meek recently moved back to the community and is interested in learning more about programs and Lower Gwynedd parks.

### **3. Consideration of February 17 Meeting Minutes**

The February 17, 2025, meeting minutes were approved as presented.

### **4. Pen Ambler Batting Cages**

Ms. High discussed the donation of a batting cage at the Pen Ambler Baseball Fields. The donation is from Spring-Fort Admiral, a youth boys' team.

The master plan map was presented, and Ms. High and Ms. Morris explained the proposed location for the cages, which is between home plate and third base, on the other side of the trail. In addition to the donation, Militello Painting and Powerwashing will paint the outfield flagpoles.

Ms. High consulted Public Works on the location and installation, which was approved by the Public Works Director.

Ms. Martin mentioned informing LGLL of the donation and how it could be used during games and practices, as well as by all Lower Gwynedd residents.

The Board approved the donation and recommended it to the Board of Supervisors.

### **8. Program Director Report**

Ms. High provided an overview of upcoming events for the 2026 season. New events include a rain barrel presentation, Republic Trash presentation, Mahjongg, and Techno Trash.

Ms. High announced plans to create a six-month program booklet, which will be released on September 1, 2026. This booklet will include all Township events and activities.

The Park and Recreation Board will be spearheading a Holiday Bazaar to take place in December at the Community Building. The Board will be creating a subcommittee. More details to follow.

### **9. Supervisor Update**

Ms. Martin shared details about a new playground proposal for Ingersoll Park, which will honor the history of the former schoolhouse, McCormick House. Ms. Martin also mentioned that the snack stand/press box building is nearly complete and is expected to be finished by Opening Day, April 11, 2026.
